
Region X Northern Mindanao

 (4.5%) among 17 regions




Northern Mindanao Economic Performance: 1990-2019


Proposed Metro CDO Sustainable Urban Infrastructure Projects

1. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

1.1. Contracting Authority

The FY 2020 National Expenditure Program (NEP) has allocated funds Research and Development to be administered by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) for the conduct of relevant studies that would support the implementation of the Philippine Development Plan and the Regional Development Plans for 2017-2022. Thus, the NEDA Regional Office X (NEDA-X) proposed a study on the Competitiveness Analysis of Northern Mindanao as a Potential Location for the Establishment of an Integrated Steel Mill (ISM) for consideration and inclusion under the said fund.

NEDA X shall be the Implementing Agency. The proposed project is one of NEDA-X's priority policy researches as indicated in the Regional Policy Research Agenda (RDPRA) 2017-2022.

1.2. Relevant country/sector context

The Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 aims at achieving increased local and foreign investments particularly in manufacturing, agriculture, and services. At the regional level, the Regional Development Plan of Northern Mindanao 2017-2022 as one of its strategies encourage larger investments through the growth of heavy industries particularly backbone industries, such as the steel industry.
