


Metro CDO Power Profile







Policy and Development Trends

- Republic Act 11285: Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act
 - Local Governments to formulate Local Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (LEECP)
 - Potential increase in demand for renewables in the energy mix
- Cagayan de Oro currently drafting its Local Energy Code, LEECP








REXPRIP VI: Villanueva-Tagoloan-CDO-Opol Expressway


Alternative Alignment Option 2 (Bukidnon-Cagayan de Oro-Iligan Road Periphery)
