

- Construct flyovers; interchanges and underpasses







# ALTERNATE ROAD FROM REGION XI TO REGION X (JCT. DC DIV. ROAD - CATALUNAN GRANDE - TALANDANG – SUMIMAO - PAÑALUM - TAPAK - CABANGLASAN - AGLAYAN, MALAYBALAY)



This road will connect Davao City and Davao Del Norte to Malaybalay, Bukidnon in Region XII and will serve as another alternative route in cutting short travel time especially from Davao Del Norte to RXII. Also, this will strengthen interregional linkage between the two regions.

**Total Length = 65.941 Km Funding Year : 2018 – 2023** 



# BUKIDNON - COMPOSTELA VALLEY ROAD, BRGY. NAMNAM, SAN FERNANDO, BUKIDNON - LAAK, DAVAO DE ORO



This road will connect the provinces of Davao De Oro and Davao Del Norte of RXI to Brgy. Namnam, Malaybalay Road, Region X thereby strengthening the inter-regional linkage of the two regions especially in the exchange of goods and services. This shall also provide shorter travel time from Laak, Davao De Oro to San Fernardo, Bukidnon. This will also serve as a gateway to address local tribal disputes and insurgencies in the area.







# ISLAND GARDEN CITY OF SAMAL (IGACOS) CIRCUMFERENTIAL ROAD DAVAO DEL NORTE








